# What happens next:

- A Notice of your application will be posted on the NWCPO website to advise any person that they may make a submission on your application.
- Notification of your application will be circulated to all Local Authorities in whose areas you
  propose to collect waste, inviting their submissions.
- Within 15 working days, the NWCPO must carry out an assessment of the application to determine if additional information is required.
- If additional information is required, it will be requested from the applicant. On receipt of any additional information the application will proceed to the next stage in the process. In order to expedite the application it is important to submit any outstanding information requested within the timeframe stated.

# Points to note regarding your application:

- You should ensure the following documentation has been included with your application:
  - An original (hard copy) Statutory Declaration (Appendix 1), completed fully, in the correct legal entity and signed by the applicant if a sole trader and all Directors if a company.
  - Where the applicant or any director has been convicted of a relevant offence, a copy of the court conviction certificate(s) relevant to that offence.
- If you had a previous permit, ensure your Annual Return is complete and submitted
- In order to demonstrate that an applicant is a Fit and Proper Person to hold a waste collection permit, they must provide evidence of their technical competence. Include copies of certificates demonstrating that appropriate training has been undertaken. If not yet undertaken, evidence that the applicant is booked onto a relevant course.
